We Are Whatawhata School, a U4, full primary catering for students in Years 0-8. We are a small rural full primary school just to the West of Hamilton City and at the heart of the Whatawhata Community.



We look to develop the whole child, empowering them to succeed in learning and life in a community that cares. Our school curriculum is built around this vision, where we support children to grow their sense of belonging, to enjoy learning knowledge, skills, principles and values that help them to meet the opportunities that life brings with a caring and can-do attitude.

Our curriculum has a holistic focus. Staff are committed to providing the best education for all our learners within a community that values manaakitanga and whanaaungatanga. Our size and focus on learning means we are able to develop an in-depth knowledge of their interests, strengths and needs which allows us to shape programmes accordingly. We pride ourselves on our relationships and knowing our children.
